ZEISSET and EPP Families

The Epp family lived in Menzingen since the mid-1600s or earlier. <u>Michael Epp</u> was an Oil Miller and a carpenter. His son, <u>Johann Jacob Epp</u> (1677-1752), was an Oil Miller and a court official. Then the next sons were: Johann Peter Epp (1709-1781), Johann Jakob Epp (1743-1800) and then <u>Bernhard Friedrich Epp</u> (1790-1840) who married Catherina Grudina in Michelfeld, Baden in 1816. Bernhard and Catharina were the parents of <u>Johanna Epp</u> (1817-1889) who married <u>Jakob Zeisset</u> (1816-1861) in 1838.

Zeisset Family moved to Menzingen from Lautenbach in 1825:

<u>Johannes Zeisset</u> (1794-1855) and wife <u>Christina Bär</u> (1798-1866) and children: <u>Jakob</u> (1816-1861) left 1851

Magdalena (1819-1884) (Baer at Niedersteinach) left 1839 Barbara (1828-1884) (Schmutz at Obersteinach) left 1850 Matthäus (1830-1896) (Raphael's ancestor) left abt. 1870?

<u>Johann</u> (1833-1878) (Illinois) left 1854 **Abraham** (1838-?) (Durlach) left 1868?

At Menzigen, the Zeissets were tenants of an estate, managing the farm.
