## Time Line

- 1862: Juergen born in Manslagt über Embden, Germany to Reinders Nanninga and Geelke Garrelts
- 1868: Bertha Zeisset born in Kreuzfeld, Germany to Jakob Friedrich Zeisset and Margaretha Mueller
- 1871: Juergen emigrated with parents from Bremen to Baltimore on SS Iris
- 1881: Margaretha Mueller Zeisset dies at Kreuzfeld, Germany
- 1882: Bertha is confirmed at Krailshausen, Germany
- 1884: Jakob Friedrich Zeisset dies in Schwäbisch Hall, Germany



- 1885: Bertha and sister Bettie come on SS Fulda to New York City from Bremen Travel to Kansas to meet the Baer family (arrived in New York in June)
- 1885: Bertha works for Richard Burk family, a Leonardville merchant Bertha joined the German Methodist church in Leonardville
- 1886: Bertha married Juergen at the home of Juergen's parents in March Settled on farm in Bala Twp. a mile south and half mile east of Leonardville
- 1887: Galena is born
- 1889: Henry is born
- 1890: Reinhardt is born; Jake Zeisset arrives from Germany
- 1891: Lizzie Zeisset arrives from Germany
- 1892: Louise is born
- 1893: Henry Zeisset arrives from Germany to live with Nanningas for a year
- 1894: Bettie is born
- 1895: Margaret is born
- 1897: Juergen is born
- 1899: Jacob is born
- 1901: Albert is born
- 1902: Carl is born
- 1904: Bertha is born
- 1906: Daniel is born
- 1908: Emilie is born
- 1909: Milton is born
- 1911: Galena marries Albert Berk and moves to Cloud County in March Louise marries Ezra Trost and moves to Cloud County, Kansas in March Elizabeth is born in December



- 1912: Son Juergen dies of diabetes after a 24 hour illness (insulin discovered 1922)
- 1914: Bettie marries Henry Jansen in February at the Nanninga home and moves to Cloud County Reinhardt dies of carcinoma of the knee, after amputation in August
- 1917: Henry marries Alma Weinert in Falls City, Nebraska
- 1918: Juergen dies of pneumonia from influenza in the Great Flu Epidemic in October

## 1924: Mother Bertha dies

- 1928: Bertha marries Fred Heikes
- 1929: Jacob marries Velma Rowland in Minnesota; Emilie marries Roy Lagerquist
- 1930: Carl marries Alberta Heikes in August Albert marries Hilma Nordren in December in El Reno, Oklahoma
- 1931: Margaret marries George Trumpp in El Reno, Oklahoma (Jacob is pastor)
- 1933: Daniel marries Fern Specht
- 1934: Elizabeth marries Orrie Morlong in Abilene, Kansas in May Milton marries Helen Stewart in Kansas City, Kansas in August
- 1941: Carl Nanninga dies in Concordia, Kansas 3 weeks before the birth of his only child, Linda, who lived one day
