1864: George Nariget Weller is born in

Onolzheim, Germany

1870: Lizzie is born in Kreuzfeld to Jakob

Zeisset and Margaretha Mueller

1878: George is confirmed in Onolzheim;

eventually worked for Jakob Zeisset

1881: Margaretha Mueller dies in Kreuzfeld

1884: Lizzie goes with Jake to live with Uncle Isaak Zeisset family in Eichenau

Lizzie is confirmed at Lendsiedel, the church serving Eichenau

Jakob Zeisset dies in Schwäbisch Hall in October

George Weller works for Isaak Zeisset at Eichenau (?)

1888: Lizzie moves to Darstadt with the Isaak Zeisset family

George Weller moves to Darstadt with the Isaak Zeisset family

1891: Lizzie arrives in New York City in April on the SS Lahn

George Weller arrives in New York City in July on the SS Trave

Lizzie and George are married in October

Probably lived 1 mile east and 1 mile north of Riley, Kansas

Bertha is born in December

1893: Lucy is born in January and dies in March; Henry Zeisset arrives from Germany in April

1894: George is born

1896: Louise is born

1899: Minnie is born

1901: Lillian is born

1906: Carl is born

1910-1915: Moved to farm two miles south of Leonardville, renting from Christian Hoch

1915: Bertha marries Oliver Nelson in Riley

1920: Lizzie and George have moved to farm 1 mile east of Leonardville

1920: Louise marries Alva Morris in April

1925: Lillian marries Gus Carlson in Manhattan

1926: Minnie marries John Uhlenhop

1927: George marries Marie Nelson

After 1930: Lizzie and George move to farm 1 mile north of Riley on Rt 24

1938: Lizzie dies of stomach cancer at Leonardville

1939: Carl marries Una Coutermarsh at the Coutermarsh home near Bala

1940: George lives with son, George

1948: Moves to Wamego Nursing Home

1957: George moves to Manhattan Nursing Home; dies in Manhattan, Kansas
